



ODOT has filed a letter of intent to pursue FHWA Emergency Relief funds for repair of damage resulting from flooding beginning April 30, 2019. Our office designates this potential ER event as ER-OK19-1. Attached is a letter from ODOT's Chief Engineer voicing ODOT's support for the affected counties, cities and communities of Oklahoma.

ODOT is currently collecting information regarding damage to the local Urban Principal Arterial and Minor Arterial system in Cities over 5,000 population. This information will help both ODOT and FHWA to expedite the process of ascertaining damage, and preparing the Detailed Damage Inspection Reports (DDIR). For Cities under 5,000 we can also accept their damage survey reports and will forward this information to FEMA for their assistance.
