**Oklahoma Municipal Services Corporation announces  
new partnership with SurgePays**

Oklahoma City, OK – The Oklahoma Municipal Services Corporation (OMSC), the business arm of the Oklahoma Municipal League (OML) has announced a new partnership with SurgePays, an electronic utility payment system.

According to SurgePays, the primary benefit of their payment system is that citizens are not required to physically visit city hall to pay their utility bills. Through their participation with SurgePays, the municipality can offer a simpler, more convenient way in which citizens can pay their bills by visiting a website or a participating local merchant.

SurgePays collects a small processing fee with every transaction and passes on a portion of that fee to the municipality and the local merchant. They will also set up the network at no cost to the municipality.
